1. Read Leviticus 17:11. What was the purpose of atonement? Why did sacrifices need to be made for sins to be atoned? How did atonement work?
2. Read Leviticus 16:29-34 and Galatians 3:10-27. What was the result for the people of Israel after the sacrifices of the Day of Atonement? How does Galatians 3 relate to the Day of Atonement?
3. The sacrifices of the Day of Atonement had to be repeated annually, along with all the other sacrifices that were given to the people of Israel. Hebrew 9 through 10 details how Jesus is that final and complete sacrifice. Read Hebrews 9:11-14. How did Jesus fulfill the law? To what end are we declared clean by the blood of Jesus?
4. How is atonement in the Old Testament different from the New Testament?
