Read 1 Corinthians 3:1-4. What is the issue that Paul is addressing here? Why was it such a problem?

Read 1 Corinthians 3:5. Why does Paul ask the question “What is Apollos? What is Paul?” instead of ‘Who is Apollos? Who is Paul?’ Why is this distinction important?

1 Corinthians 3:10b says ‘Let each one take care how he builds upon it (the foundation of Jesus).’ The Corinthians were building a church, a local body of believers. How were they building it? Why was this a problem?

Read 1 Corinthians 3:12-15. Why does some work get burned up and some survive the fire of ‘The Day?’ Doesn’t God value everything we do for Him?

Why is it a problem if we work towards a Christ-focused goal in a non-Christ-focused way?

What are you building? What are some of the primary goals you are working towards in this season of life?

How can you be sure to build those things in a Christ-like way? Is this easy or hard for you? Why?
