

Sons and Daughters: 1 Corinthians 6:1-11

When people find themselves in conflict, they respond in one of two ways: fight or flight. When you find yourself in conflict, do you try to avoid it hoping it goes away, or, do you go to war with a desire to win?

Read 1 Corinthians 6:1-9. How were some within the church at Corinth responding to conflict?

Paul asks a number of questions to challenge the church. What was his point in asking all these questions? Why did he use this tone with them?

Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11. In verse 11, Paul reminds them of their identity in Jesus. How does who they are in Jesus affect how they handle conflict?

How does the knowledge that you are washed, sanctified (set apart for God) and justified, affect the way you work through difficulties with another Christ follower?
