How does this reality of demon worship affect the way you view the idols in your own life?

Paul challenges the Corinthians in ver 12 to "take heed." What are they supposed to be watching for? What are the consequences of not being aware?

We are all tempted in one way or another. How does Paul encourage the church in verse 13? What promises do you see in this verse when facing temptation?
