How did this betray Jesus' call to love one another (see John 13:35)?

What are the ways our hearts can be shaped by our culture? How can that work its way into the church?

If the Lord's Supper (Communion) calls us to celebrate Jesus surrendering all for on our behalf, what might we need to surrender to love our brothers and sisters?
