1. Read the whole of Romans 8. What stands out to you?
2. Go back to verse 15. What has God not given His children? What would our lives look like if we were slaves to fear? How can you identify if you are a slave to fear?
3. What has God given His children? How did God make this happen?
4. What does it mean to be a child of God? How does being a joint heir with Jesus Christ affect the way you approach God? How does it affect your approach to other people?
5. Hypothetical situation: You have a 'friend' whom you would identify as a 'slave to fear.' How would you try to help them understand that they are a child of God?
6. When you look in the mirror tonight, say the things you would say to your 'friend.' After all, from time to time, we can look more like 'slaves to fear' than children of God.
