STUDY GUIDE

1. Read 2 Kings 5:1-14. How would you describe Naaman's initial reaction to Elisha's message (vv. 11-12)? What was he expecting?
2. How did Naaman's anger interfere with understanding what God called him to do? What can interfere with our ability to respond in faith to the Lord?
3. What impact did other people — the young girl (v. 2) and the servant (v. 13) — have in leading Naaman to trust?
4. In Luke 4:27, Jesus mentions Naaman. What was his reason for doing so?
5. Think about someone who encouraged you during a time when you felt you were at a spiritual low point. How did they encourage you?
6. How might God use you to encourage someone whose faith is wavering?
