Review Ephesians 2. What does Paul say about our position as followers of Jesus? Why is understanding our position important?

In Ephesians 3:1-13 Paul reiterates why he was called by God to be an apostle — to invite people who are far from God into the family of God. In verse 6 what do you think Paul is referring to when he says “partakers of the promise?”

Read Ephesians 3:14-16. What does Paul pray for the Christians in Ephesus? Have you ever prayed these things for someone? What things do you usually pray for people?

Read Ephesians 3:17. What does Paul pray that the Christians in Ephesus would grab hold of?

Read Ephesians 3:18-19. What is the second thing Paul wants them to comprehend or grab hold of? What other challenges do you find in these verses?

Spend some time as a group trying to describe the love of Christ. Think of as many different ways to explain it as you can. Was it difficult or easy? Why or why not? How does the amount of different ways to describe Christ’s love help us when talking to others about Jesus?
