Why is it essential that we ask the question 'What does God say?' as we encounter complex issues like this?

Read Ephesians 4:25-32. How does this passage relate to taking off the old self and putting on the new self that we talked about last week?

Read Ephesians 4:25. Why is it important for us, as Christians, to tell the truth? Is it ever acceptable to lie? What about white lies?

Read Ephesians 4:26-27. Is it ok to be angry? Give an example of a situation you've recently experienced where you think you were justified in being angry. How can we be angry and make sure we don't sin?

Read Ephesians 4:28. Is it ever ok to steal? Is it morally acceptable to steal something that somebody else stole? How does this impact our thoughts about Robin Hood?

Read Ephesians 4:29. What is 'corrupting talking?' How do we know whether we're using 'corrupting' or toxic language when we talk with someone else? Why is this type of talk unacceptable for a Christian? Is it always unacceptable? Why?

Read Ephesians 4:30. What does it mean to grieve the Holy Spirit?

Read Ephesians 4:31-32. If you were to describe how you engage in conflict, what would be words that you would use? How does this compare with what Paul describes in these verses?
